

## VTAC Applications Open

This week in Futures, Year 12 students were encouraged and supported to begin their VTAC applications. VTAC is the organisation who:

- Calculates the ATAR
- Manages the application process for places in Victorian tertiary institutions
- Manages Scholarships and SEAS applications

All Year 12 VCE and VCE VM students will be supported by our Careers Leader, Laura Lunardi, to make a VTAC application. Each student will have the opportunity to meet with Ms Lunardi to discuss careers, courses of interest and the process of applying through VTAC.

There are tertiary opportunities for all students and we encourage all students to make an application for further study at either University or TAFE. Research shows that higher levels of education lead to higher rates of employment, greater income and greater community involvement and improved family and child wellbeing. Students can apply for certificates, diploma and bachelor degree courses, ensuring they have the opportunity to continue to build their skills and knowledge to contribute to the world.

## SEAS - Special Entry Access Scheme

SEAS applications are available to students when submitting their VTAC application. SEAS applications compensate for educational disadvantage by making an application more competitive. The application is made via VTAC and provided to tertiary institutions who consider each application separately, increasing a student's selection rank where appropriate.

There are 4 categories for SEAS applications:

- Category 1: Personal information and location. This category includes age, living or school location, under-representation of a gender in a course or field of study, recognition as an Indigenous Australian, recognition for being from a non-English speaking background and recognition for being the first in your family to attend tertiary study.
- Category 2: Disadvantaged financial background
- Category 3: Disability or medical condition
- Category 4: Difficult circumstances

## Scholarships

Scholarships are available for a range of tertiary institutions. Students can apply for scholarships for Academic Merit and Access and Equity categories.

## Early Entry Schemes

A number of tertiary institutions offer the opportunity to apply for early offers. These offers allow students some reassurance of a university place before the completion of exams. These places are conditional on the student meeting the requirements of the course such as a particular minimum score in English or a minimum ATAR. However, knowing that you have a place in a course can reassure many students. We encourage students to explore the range of courses where early entry is available. A VTAC application is still required to accept this offer and other courses can still be preferred even if a student has been given an early offer.

### How to become a Police Officer - State

Police officers protect the community from crime and disorder by providing services to uphold the law, protect life and property, preserve the peace, prevent crime, detect and apprehend offenders, and help those in need of assistance.

#### Education & Training for a Police Officer

To become a police officer at state or territory level, you usually have to gain your Senior Secondary Certificate of Education, although requirements vary. Entry to this occupation may be improved if you have tertiary qualifications. Institutions have different prerequisites and some have flexible entry requirements or offer external study.
